**What is it?** The Faculty & Staff Learning Community builds on a history of successful learning communities. The FSLC includes regular cohort meetings to introduce resources and best practices, provide time for individual project planning, and building a community of practice.

**When is it? What is the time commitment?** The FSLC will meet biweekly throughout the spring semester, tentatively planned for Fridays 2-3 pm. Alternate weeks are reserved for time to develop individual projects, do readings, and connect with other resources.

**Who can participate?** Faculty and Staff; limited to 12.

**Compensation:** All participants receive a stipend of \$500 following completion of the learning community and \$500 following implementation and evaluation of their project. There is also seed money available to support project work.
